The extensive menu, which reads as a who's who in the world of whiskey, has been thoughtfully curated with unique and rare pours that include small vintage collections, private barrel flights and a range of approachable selections. Whiskey Bar's cuisine will complement the savory profiles that pair well with the distilled spirit and is built around the bar's stone hearth pizza ovens. In true Archer fashion, details big and small will round out the immersive experience, including a complimentary arrival bar snack and games to test one's whiskey wisdom.

Whiskey Bar hosts who are passionate about nurturing the perfect pour will guide guests through the experience, which showcases such rare and allocated whiskeys as Pappy Van Winkle, EH Taylor Barrel Proof, Weller Full Proof, Orphan Barrels, Elmer T Lee and Yamazaki. Global selections include Irish, Scotch (Highland, Speyside, Islay and Blended), Japanese, Canadian and American varieties. A small vintage collection features Teitessa 30 Year, The Balvenie 30 Year and Red Breast 27 Year. One-of-a-kind private barrel flights, selected via blind tastings throughout the year, will constantly evolve and serve as the base for Whiskey Bar's specialty cocktail list with such creative compositions as The Bee's Whisktea, Blazen Manhattan and Private Jet.

With sweeping valley vistas, the 30-seat enclave is tucked neatly in the corner of Sky & Vine, the only spot in downtown that boasts such a vantage point from its sixth-floor perch atop Archer Hotel Napa. The intimate space is anchored by a stone fireplace and furnished with Sonoma redwood Adirondack chairs and one-of-a-kind tasting tables and benches handcrafted exclusively for Whiskey Bar by <u>Sonoma Woodworks</u>. The 12-seat covered bar boasts up-close pizza oven and golden bottle views.

A whiskey haunt in wine country is a natural fit given those who seek out the destination and why, according to Archer Hotel Napa's corporate food & beverage director, Peter Triolo. "Food

and beverage enthusiasts now have even more reasons to visit Napa Valley. After a day of wine tasting, gastronomes have a growing list of breweries, distilleries, craft cocktail venues — and now a dedicated whiskey bar — to add to their tasting tour."

The impressive whiskey collection will share the stage with thoughtful culinary pairings turned out from the stone hearth ovens. Sure to be shareable favorites are such savory seasonal selections as smoked pork ribs served dry with hatch chile rub or wet with house made BBQ sauce; creamy white cheddar shallot mac 'n' cheese with braised short rib; crispy pork belly bites with fig mustard sauce; and two tempting pizza pies — white mushroom with ricotta, mozzarella and garlic; and margherita with balsamic, cherry tomatoes, caramelized onions and burrata. The menu also features chick-arrones, baked oysters and mussels, pretzels and pizza knots. A signature bourbon berry crisp with mixed berries, oat streusel and bourbon Chantilly cream is the perfect dessert nightcap.

Whiskey Bar at Sky & Vine welcomes guests with a complimentary arrival bar snack — salami bites from Napa's <u>Fatted Calf Charcuterie</u> — and complementary bar games to test whiskey wisdom, such as Whiskey Business!, Ridley's Whisky Lover's Deck of Playing Cards and The Whisky Game — a board game to match this popular tipple.
